

BYRD'S COMPETITIVE TUMBLE TEAM 2023-24



Byrd's Competitive Tumble Team is a selected group of gymnasts & tumblers that compete in meets held in the Kansas City area. Students from throughout the greater Kansas City area participate and compete against one another for placement awards. Participating on Tumble Team is a great way to enhance skill development and gain confidence in a competitive environment.

Team members learn a compulsory routine that consists of three tumbling passes. The routine they will learn is based on their skill level. There are many skill levels that students can advance through from pre-school to Level 10. Additionally, all tumblers compete in the mini-trampoline category and those with the acquired skill of a back handspring may be eligible to compete in the power tumbling category.

Class Requirements:

Members of Tumble Team are required to attend a weekly team practice.

Practice Schedule:

Tumble Team will begin the new season starting June 6th, 2023.

Dress Code:

A leotard is required for Tuesday team practices. Tumblers may wear athletic style booty shorts or leggings over their leotard. **No sports bras with shorts.** A compression shirt and athletic shorts are required for boys.

Competition:

Competitions are held locally in the greater Kansas City area. Tumblers are judged on different elements for each event and may be awarded ribbons, medals or trophies for their placement.

Commitment:

Becoming a member of a competitive tumbling team requires a strong commitment from both the tumbler and the parent. It is important that team members participate in every practice and maintain a commitment to the sport in order to be successful. Competitive tumbling is a highly rewarding sport that develops and enhances discipline, responsibility, goal setting, time-management skills, self-esteem and confidence. The physical and mental benefits will be carried with your child throughout their life.

Tumblers will participate in five meets:
one meet in October, November, January, February & March.

Team members must purchase a team leotard.
Leotards will be worn for one season.

Team members must purchase a team warm-up jacket.
Jackets will be worn for two consecutive seasons.

The following are included in monthly fees:

- Class tuition
- Meet Entry Fees for five meets for one compulsory routine & one mini tramp entry

Tumble Team Practice Schedule (coaches will assign based on age & level):

Tuesday 5:00-6:30	\$140/month
Tuesday 6:30-8:30	\$160/month

The following are NOT included in your monthly fee and are charged separately:

- Competition Leotard approx. \$125 plus tax
- Team Warm-up Jacket (new members) approx. \$125 plus tax
- Power Tumbling Entries (optional) approx. \$15 per event (for qualified participants)

Competition leotards are NOT to be worn at practice

Monthly fees must be current in order for your child to be entered in competitions. Competition entries are sent off 90 to 120 days in advance of the event.

Those with past due accounts run the risk of their tumbler NOT being entered in a meet. We are not obligated to contact you about your past due account. We reserve the right to omit any gymnast's entry because of a past due account regardless if the meet fee is paid.

Team fees are non-refundable.
